6. DESCRIPTION OF UNIT OPERATION:

UPON THEIR ARRIVAL THEY WERE BRIEFED BY THE NIGHT TOUR AND BEGAN OPERATIONS. EXTINGUISHMENT WAS COMPLETED BY THE DAY TOUR AND THE NIGHT TOUR STAY FOR SUPPORT AND BACKUP OF THE DAY TOURS OPERATIONS.

ALL OPERATIONS WERE CONDUCTED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS. FIREFIGHTING IN LEVEL "B" PROTECTIVE CLOTHING UNDER EXTREME CONDITIONS, (SUITS NOT DESIGNED FOR FIREFIGHTING) ON AN EXTREMELY HOT AND HUMID DAY. LONG STRETCHES REQUIRING AT LEAST FOUR FIREFIGHTERS FOR ADVANCEMENT OF THE LINE.

LONG OPERATION AT LEAST 8 HOURS IN LENGTH WITH NO RELIEF POSSIBLE BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE CONTAMINATION PROBLEMS. ENTIRE COMPANY COMMITTED AND EVEN THOUGH UNDERMANNED (DOING HAZ-MAT, ENGINE & TRUCK WORK COMBINED) STILL MANAGED TO COMPLETE THE OPERATION. BOTH TOURS MADE MULTIPLE ENTRIES INTO THE SITE IN ADDITION TO PROVIDING RELIEF TO EACH OTHER AS WELL AS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.

IT IS FOR THIS REASON I RESPECTFULLY REQUEST CONSIDERATION BY THE BOARD OF MERIT.

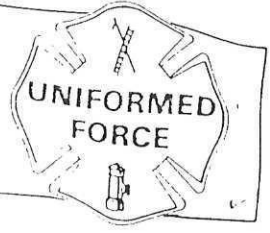
